Her series Shelf Life just wrapped its 4th season ([shelflifeseries.com](http://shelflifeseries.com)) with an award nom at the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Geekie Awards, where she was an invited judge at the gala ceremony on August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2013. Recent guest spots include appearances on the cooking shows Eat.Taste.Live and Cooking With Celebs.
